WHEN COMING FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT BE SURE TO BRING

Photo IDs and Social Security Card or ITINs for you and your dependents

Last year's return (2015) and supporting paperwork for the 2016 return

W2 Wage Statement, Social Security Statement, All 1099 forms and K1 forms received

Broker, Bank and Mutual Fund Year End Statements including the Cost Basis of any stocks or bonds sold

Backup for all of your deductions and credits

Real Estate Tax, Mortgage and Rental Information

Contributions, Medical Expenses and Child Care Expenses

Tuition, books and other college fees for you and your dependents

All 2016 federal and state tax booklets including the PTR that you have received

Affordable care act participants must bring Form 1095-A
