### Notice of Cancellation - Maple Shade 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration

May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2020

The Maple Shade Town Council has made the difficult decision to cancel the Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration and Fireworks scheduled for Saturday June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2020 in compliance with Governor Murphy's Executive Order #107.

This decision was made after considering the many aspects of staffing, financial obligations and the overall execution of the event amid the current public health concerns and economic uncertainty of the next few months.

Our first priority is the health and safety of our community. We also must be fiscally responsible and avoid penalties and cancellation fees if we fail to give proper notification to the vendor. These considerations are what have made the decision necessary.

We are extremely grateful for the community's support of this annual event and realize what it means to our residents; with that in mind we are looking to reschedule the event for Labor Day Weekend.
