### **Resolution Authorizing Participation in the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, Established by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, to Apply for and Receipt, \$1,933,856.21 to Respond to Acute Pandemic Response Needs, Fill Revenue Shortfalls and Improve Water and Sewer System Infrastructures**

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) (P.L. 117-2) was signed into law by President Biden on March 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the latest in a series of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) related relief and economic stimulus legislation; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 established the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, designed to deliver \$350 billion to State, Local, Territorial, and Tribal governments to bolster their response to the COVID-19 emergency and its economic impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, of the \$130.2 billion allotted for local governments, the Township of Maple Shade has been allocated \$1,933,856.21 that will be provided in two payments, in which 50% of the funding will be provided on or about May 2021 with the balance provided approximately 12 months later after successful submission of all supporting documentation: and

**WHEREAS**, funds may only be used to cover costs incurred during the period beginning March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, and ending December 31, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds may be used for purposes including, but not limited to the following:

- Replacing lost public sector revenue, using this funding to provide government services to the extent of the reduction in revenue experienced due to the pandemic.
- Investing in water, sewer, and broadband infrastructure, making necessary investments to improve access to clean drinking water, support vital wastewater and stormwater infrastructure and to expand access to broadband internet.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township of Maple Shade Township Council, that the Township of Maple Shade participates in the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds, and accepts receipt of \$1,933,856.21 in funding which is in the best interest of the public; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Financial Officer, Township Manager and Mayor are hereby authorized and directed to sign and file, or cause to be filed, on behalf of the Township of Maple Shade, the request for Funding, together with any such other certificates, documents, instruments or notices as may be necessary or as any such authorized official may deem necessary or desirable, in order to effectuate or carry out the purposes and intent of this Resolution, and that all such action heretofore taken by any one or more of the authorized officials in order to effectuate or carry out the purposes and intent of the foregoing Resolution are hereby ratified, adopted and approved.
